### REFUSE- TICKET REQUIRED: One (1) \$6.00 ticket for every 125 lbs. of refuse including:

Residential & Commercial Refuse	Burnable Wood: Doors, Windows,
Mattresses & Box Springs - Carpets	All Decking, Plywood, Wood Shingles, Railroad Ties
Underlay - Upholstered Furniture	Insulation - Linoleum

RECYCLABLES (Newspaper, Mixed Paper, Bottles, Cans, Plastics #1 - #7) AND CORRUGATED CARDBOARD - FREE

### NO LIQUIDS, PROPANE TANKS, ROCKS OR DIRT

### DEMOLITION MATERIALS- TICKET REQUIRED: One \$12.00 ticket for every 125 lbs. of demolition materials including:

Sheetrock - Concrete - Ceramic Tile - Roof Shingles - Dishware - Tar - Toilets - Sinks - Cement - Bricks -  
Plasterboard - Plaster - (Driveway Patch/Sealer -Only If Dry Or Congealed)

All latex-based paint within cans must be dry before being disposed of in your garbage.  
All oil-based paint must go to the Hazardous Waste Collection.

## 211 GARDER ROAD - LANDFILL

Open: Friday & Saturday, 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

### BRUSH: TICKET REQUIRED: \$6.00 each

Brush/Wood over 3 inches in diameter or 4 feet long - three (3) tickets per car load  
- five (5) tickets per truck load up to 1 Ton (pickup/mason truck)  
- eight (8) tickets per truck load over 1 Ton (dump truck)

OR - \$10.00 yearly sticker from July 1 thru June 30 allows unlimited disposal of brush 3 inches in diameter or smaller  
or one (1) ticket per car load or two (2) tickets per truck load.

Senior citizens 65 & over can obtain the yearly \$10.00 brush sticker FREE at Town Hall - I.D. and registration required.

### OTHER: TICKET REQUIRED:

Freon Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners) - \$15.00 each

Tires - \$2.00 each

Propane Tanks - \$5.00 each

Scrap Metal - (Stoves, Washers, Dryers) - FREE

Leaves/Grass (you unbag) - FREE

Electronics (TVs, computers, etc.) - FREE

**VEHICLE MUST BE REGISTERED IN MONROE - NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**
